



What Your Child Learned Today..

That will save their life!!

Today, Beaufort Firefighters played a game with your child, and:

- Taught your child “what’s hot, what’s not”
- Taught your child to stay away from hot items
- Taught your child “what are tools, what are toys”
- Taught your child matches and lighters are adult tools
- Taught your child to tell an adult when they see matches and lighters
- Taught your child what a smoke detector sounds like, and the need to “get out and stay out!”

You can help Beaufort Firefighters keep your child safe by:

- Show your child all the hot items in your home
- Teach your child that matches and lighters are adult tools for work - not toys, and to tell you when they see them lying around
- Show them your home’s smoke detectors and what they sound like
- Practice with your child on what they should do when they hear their detector. Remember, don’t open hot doors and that windows are exits to –don’t hide!!
- ***Do not teach your child to ignore the sound of the smoke detectors by dismissing accidental activations during cooking, that is the best time to practice!!***
